International Tables for Crystallography, Volume F: Crystallography of Biological Macromolecules, 2001, Michael G. Rossmann & Eddy Arnold, Editors, Kluwer Academic Publishers, Dordrecht/Boston/London, 832 pp., was published in July 2001. Volume F comprises 26 chapters and a total of 72 articles written by 156 authors. More than 1300 copies of Volume F have been sold as of mid-January 2005.
